

ANNOUNCEMENT

Temporary Closure of the Royal Thai Embassy on 23 July 2025

The Royal Thai Embassy wishes to inform the public that the Embassy will be closed on Wednesday, 23 July 2025, following the issuance of Memorandum Circular No. 90 by the Office of the President of the Philippines. The Circular declares the suspension of work in government offices and classes at all levels in the National Capital Region and certain provinces due to continuous heavy rainfall brought by the southwest monsoon (Habagat), upon the recommendation of the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (NDRRMC).

During this time, e-visa applications may still be submitted through the Embassy's online visa platform at www.thaievisa.go.th. However, please note that the processing time may be longer than the standard timeframe due to the temporary closure.

Normal operations will resume once the situation allows and subject to further announcements from the Philippine authorities.
